#### Who we are

### What you'll do

As the School-Based Therapist, you will provide therapeutic and advocacy services to clients and families experiencing violence, trauma, and mental health concerns. You will report to the Deputy Director of Programs and Clinical Supervision and work collaboratively with all staff members and volunteers to further PAVE's mission. Key responsibilities are as follows:

- Provide individual, group, and family therapeutic interventions in partner schools
- Provide crisis interventions and advocacy services
- Assist youth and families with access to practical resources, supports, and community services
- Collaborate with parents/guardians, teachers, school administration, community and state resources on a regular basis to effectively assess need and system changes
- Track and document services data on a monthly basis
- Attend weekly individual clinical supervision and monthly group supervision meetings

### What makes you a great candidate for this role

- You have a minimum of a Master's degree and 1 year of experience in counseling, social work, psychology, or other related field
- You have comprehensive knowledge of intervention strategies, marginalized communities, and social change environments
- You have a strong understanding of secondary trauma and self-care
- You have internal motivation and drive, while excelling within a team environment

## What you will receive

The base salary for this 10.5-month position is \$48,654.
